CIRCULAR ON HANDLING OF CONTINUOUS ASSESSMENT FOR S.3 and S.4, 2026


This serves to inform you that **Continuous Assessment** for Senior 3 learners and UCE candidates 2026 shall be handled as follows;

- a) S.3 learners and S.4 candidates of 2026 shall use the **revised** Subject Observation Checklists. The **revised** Subject Observation Checklists are available on the **eRegistration portal** under **Resources**.
- b) Schools are expected to administer Activities of Integration (AoI) for Term 1 of S.3 and S.4 as outlined in the curricular books.
- c) S.3 learners are expected to undertake project work starting with the planning competency which should end by Term 2, S.3 2026 while S.4 is should finalise project implementation competency by the end of Term 1, S.4 2026
- d) UNEB shall receive Continuous Assessment scores for Subject Achievement, AoI and project work as per the schedule given in the table below;

- e) A candidate without coursework assessment scores for the **project** and the **subjects offered shall not** be graded.
- f) Any head teacher who admits a learner from another school, should ensure that the learner admitted was assessed while in S.3, 2025 as required and that his/her scores have been submitted to UNEB.
- g) Head teachers are further informed that candidates whose CA scores for S.3, 2025 have not been submitted shall not be registered for the 2026 End of Cycle Examination.
