RELEASE OF 2024 UCE TRANSITION AND NEW LOWER SECONDARY SCHOOL (NLSC) RESULTS

The Uganda National Examinations Board is pleased to release the 2024 Uganda Certificate of Education (UCE) for both Transition and NLSC results to candidates who registered in your centre. Please find the 2024 UCE results posted on your school portal.

Please urgently issue the results to the candidates to enable them to point out any errors for immediate amendment.

THE 2024 UCE TRANSITION RESULTS

1. Study and analyse the results carefully before raising any complaints about grades for any candidate. Consider the following examples:
 - Did the candidate sitting for the first time, offer a minimum of eight subjects?
 - Did the candidate select and actually sit the subjects according to regulations- e.g. all core subjects?
 - Did the candidate sit under the correct code?
 - Did the candidate use the right equated/adult code?

Note: The minimum number of subjects passed at credit level (or better) and at pass level; the actual subjects passed and the aggregate for the 8 best subjects are considered during grading.

Conditions for the Award of the UCE transition examinations are summarized below:

Result/Division 1:

Pass a minimum of **eight** subjects which must include English Language (with credit), a Humanity subject, Mathematics and, (except for visually challenged candidates), a Science subject. At least **seven** of the subjects must be passed at **credit** level or better. The aggregate for the best eight done subjects must not exceed 32.

Result/Division 2:

Pass a minimum of **eight** subjects including English Language. **Six** of the subjects must be at **credit** level or better. The aggregate for the eight best-done subjects must not exceed 45.

Result/ Division 3:

Either (i) Pass a minimum of **eight** subjects (with at least **3 credits** or better).

Or (ii) Pass a minimum of **seven** subjects (with at least **4 credits** or better).

Or (iii) Pass a minimum of **five** subjects with **credits** or better. The aggregate for the best eight done subjects must not exceed 58.

Result/ Division 4:

Either(i) Pass at least **one** subject with **credit** or better

Or (ii) Pass at least **two** subjects with **Pass 7**

Or (iii) Pass at least **three** subjects with **Pass 8** or better.

Result/Division 7:

A candidate with Result 7 has not qualified for the UCE certificate award. The candidate did not select/ sit subjects according to regulations, which infringes on the entry regulations.

THE 2024 UCE NEW LOWER SECONDARY SCHOOL RESULTS

The following are the NLSC Achievement Levels and their Descriptors:

GRADE	ACHIEVEMENT LEVEL	DESCRIPTOR
A	Exceptional	Demonstrates an extraordinary level of competency by applying innovatively and creatively the acquired knowledge and skills in real life situations.
B	Outstanding	Demonstrates a high level of competency by applying the acquired knowledge and skills in real life situations.
C	Satisfactory	Demonstrates an adequate level of competency by applying the acquired knowledge and skills in real life situations.
D	Basic	Demonstrates a minimum level of competency by applying the acquired knowledge and skills in real life situations.
E	Elementary	Demonstrates below the basic level of competency by applying the acquired knowledge and skills in real life situations.

The NLSC results are awarded using the following explanations

Result 1 Candidates who qualify to get a certificate.

Result 2 Candidates who did not fulfil the conditions for the award of the certificate.

Result 3 Candidates who do not meet the minimum level of achievements in all the subjects.

Result 4 Candidates who were either partially or fully absent.

2. Analyse all the result particulars as follows:

(a) Centre number, name and address

(b) Subject grades of each candidate against entry code and actual attendance/Achievement level, Descriptors, and Definition of terms.

(c) Name, gender, entry code and Date of Birth of each candidate.

3. Compile all amendments and/or queries arising from your analysis of the results on **the form for correction of results** downloaded from the UNEB portal. Specify the type of anomalies or queries for which the amendments are to be made. Scan the filled, signed and stamped correction of the result form and send it as an attachment to eRegSecondary@uneb.ac.ug. Submit all the queries from your centre, **not later than 4th March 2025**.
4. Many Heads of centres have not been bothering to send queries/amendments in time. You are advised alternatively to deliver the queries personally to UNEB offices, as using post systems may result in delays. If the Board does not receive your queries by **4th March**, it will be assumed that your results do not have errors. **Queries submitted after this date shall not be accepted.**

Note: Results of individual candidates may also be **accessed by SMS (all networks)**. Type UCE, leave a space, type the index number and then send to **6600**
